Four items are included with Amendment 11 to the FY 2015-2018 Transportation Improvement Program.

1. ***Updated*** FF and Weaver Sidewalks (EN1513)
FF (EN1514) and Weaver (EN1513) Sidewalk projects were combined with the addition of turning radii improvements at FF and 2nd for a programmed total of \$625,599.
2. ***Removed*** FF Sidewalks (EN1514)
Combined with EN1513.
3. ***Updated*** Intersection Improvements at Jackson and NN (OK1401)
Engineering and ROW were added to this project, using \$520,000 in STP-Urban Funding, for a new programmed total of \$670,000.
4. ***Updated*** Mt. Vernon Street Bridge over Jordan Creek (SP1605)
The project was updated to maximize available BRM funding, adding a ROW component to the project. The total BRM funding is \$982,905 and the total project is programmed for \$1,250,000.

The public comment period will continue until June 2, 2016. After reviewing recommendations and public comments, the OTO Board of Directors will decide whether to formally adopt the amendment **at an E-meeting June 2, 2016 at noon**, at 2208 W. Chesterfield Boulevard, Suite 101, Springfield, MO.

The amendment will be available for review at the Ozarks Transportation Organization offices and at ozarkstransportation.org.
