The Ozarks Transportation Organization announces a public comment period for the public to review and comment on the Annual Listing of Obligated Projects (ALOP). The ALOP is a listing of federal funds obligated on projects within the OTO area in the 2010 Federal Fiscal Year. The 2010 Federal Fiscal Year runs from October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2010.

The public comment period will begin on December 1, 2010 and end on December 15, 2010. The OTO Board of Directors will review and possibly approve the listing at a December 16, 2010 Board Meeting, held at 12:00 p.m. at 840 Boonville Avenue, Springfield MO, fourth floor conference room. After reviewing recommendations and entertaining public comment, the OTO Board of Directors will decide whether to formally approve the listing.
