The Ozarks Transportation Organization announces a public comment period for the public to review and comment on the Annual Listing of Obligated Projects (ALOP). The ALOP is a listing of federal funds obligated on projects within the OTO area in the 2011 Federal Fiscal Year. The 2011 Federal Fiscal Year runs from October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011.

A listing of the federal funds obligated will be available for review at the Ozarks Transportation Organization, 205 Park Central East, Suite 205 and at ozarkstransportation.org. The public comment period will begin on November 30, 2011 and end on December 14, 2011. The OTO Board of Directors will review and possibly approve the listing at a December 15, 2011 Board Meeting, held at 12:00 noon at 205 Park Central East, Suite 212, Springfield MO. After reviewing recommendations and entertaining public comment, the OTO Board of Directors will decide whether to formally approve the listing.
