The Ozarks Transportation Organization announces a public comment period for the public to review and comment on a proposed amendment to the 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP is a schedule of transportation improvements planned by various agencies in the Ozarks Transportation Organization boundary over the next four years. To be eligible for federal funds, a project must be included in the TIP.

The following amendment has been requested:

Modification of a sidewalk project on Kearney Street/Route 744 to include pedestrian improvements from Kansas Expressway to Glenstone Avenue.

The amendment will be available for review at the Ozarks Transportation Organization, 117 Park Central Square, Suite 107 and at ozarkstransportation.org. The public comment period will begin on April 1, 2011 and end on April 21, 2011. The OTO Board of Directors will review and possibly approve the amendments at a April 21, 2011 Board Meeting, held at 12:00 p.m. at 840 Boonville Avenue, Springfield MO, fourth floor conference room. After reviewing recommendations and entertaining public comment, the OTO Board of Directors will decide whether to formally adopt the amendments.
