




Where are we?What makes moving around the Ozarks great? What are the region's transportation strengths? (Mark all that apply)




Why can't we get there?What are the challenges facing the region today? What is the hardest part about getting around? (Mark all that apply)








Your level of congestion on your way to work?




Your level of congestion on your way home after work?




Your level of congestion to/from school?




Your level of congestion when running errands




In the short term, do you think the current level of investment should be...




In the long term, do you think the current level of investment should be...




How would you allocate \$100 of transportation funding among these categories?




Tolls on new roads or bridges




Tolls on existing roads or bridges




Increased tax on the amount of gas that you buy




Tax based on the distance that you drive instead of the amount of gas that you buy




Increased vehicle registration fees




Increased sales tax - Statewide




Increased sales tax - local







