### **1. Welcome and Introductions.**

House Bill 642 passed the House Transportation Committee and is now on the floor for debate and has a good chance for passage.

### **3. Program to identify exemplary bicycle/pedestrian streets in OTO area:** OTO staff would like to develop a program that documents best practices for bicycle and pedestrian facilities. This would be developed through nominations and analysis, including a review of before and after conditions. This would also provide local examples to include in the Bike Ped Plan. The request for nominations will be sent out to BPAC and the Technical Committee.

### **4. Plan Update – Prioritization Process for Future Identified Projects:** The question is how to prioritize projects in different communities. Factors could include retail density, residential density, transit, and/or the number of connections. The suggestion is to get the top projects from each community, then categorize and try to know the costs. Projects could then be ranked within cost categories. These would be reviewed yearly. Types of submittals would include bike, pedestrian, trail, transit (including carpool and extended transit connections), streetscape, connections, and safe routes to school. Most submittals will be local in nature. This prioritization process will not replace the competitive process for specific funding sources. At this point, each community will submit the top two priorities in each category.

As for public participation, jurisdiction specific plans will be updated, additional text will be addressed in the document, and local examples will be included.
