- **3.** Review of submissions for exemplary bicycle/pedestrian streets in OTO area. Submissions were postponed to June 19, 2009. More discussion was had on what could be submitted. It was decided that programs and citizen initiatives could also be considered beyond capital road improvements.

House Bill 642, Complete Streets, was not passed.

The next BPAC meeting will be July 7, 2009. All responses to the above programs will be forwarded to BPAC members before the next meeting.

The One-Mile Solution book was mentioned for member information. This book includes information on utility cycling. There was further discussion on the ease of riding in Springfield and Greene County.

There was discussion on the federal ARRA discretionary money for projects between \$20m and \$500m. MoDOT is applying for truck lanes on I-70.

The Missouri Trail Summit is in Springfield October 7-9 and the Missouri APA conference is also in Springfield October 21-23.
