FY 2025 Southwest Missouri Coalition for Roadway Safety Grant

Eligible Projects

Projects or equipment that will help reduce the fatal or serious injury crashes that occur on Missouri's roadways. The projects must be tied to a Strategy or Action outlined in the Show-Me-Zero Plan.

Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvement (CRISI) Program

The US DOT announced the NOFO for CRISI. This program is aimed at enhancing railroad safety, efficiency, and reliability across the US. Special consideration is given to projects that demonstrate innovation, support economic vitality, and enhance environmental sustainability.

Application Deadline: Tuesday, May 28, 2024

Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP)

Eligible Projects

ATIIP projects will help improve the safety, efficiency, and reliability of active transportation networks and communities; improve connectivity between active transportation modes and public transportation; enhance the resiliency of on- and off- road active transportation Infrastructure; help protect the environment; and improve quality of life in disadvantaged communities through the delivery of connected active transportation networks and expanded mobility opportunities.

Project Size - average award is \$100,000 to \$15,000,000

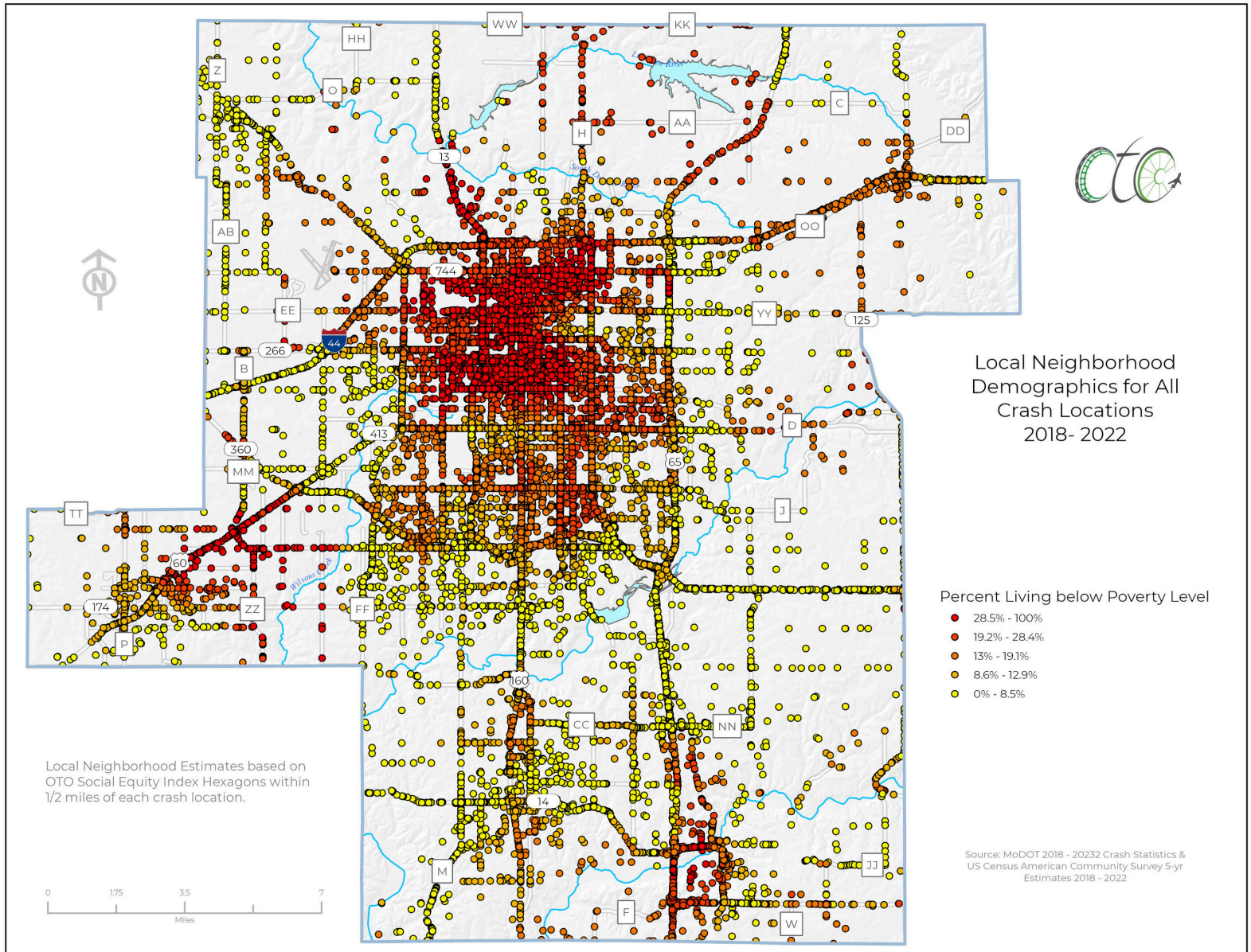


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Featured Map of the Month
