- Landowner Contact/Engagement
 - created a dashboard to track landowner engagement, created letter template and benefit of trails handout
 - contact and/or engaged with 20 public and private landowners
- Engage with local municipalities
 - Utilized existing meetings: OTO BPAC, OTO Tech, and OG Tech
 - Virtual/In-person meetings with one or more of the following: mayors, city administrators, Chambers of Commerce, commissioners in Springfield, Battlefield, Ozark, Nixa, Republic, Stafford, Willard, special committees, and Greene & Christian counties.

 - o included Trail of Tears on trail map and created UnGap the Map
 - o shifting the OG website from Springfield focus to Regional focus
