How Do Transit Grant Compliance Requirements Impact You?

When an agency accepts Federal Transit Administration (FTA) assistance through a transit grant funded project, whether for a capital project, such as a bus / van, or for public transit operating assistance, then there are grant contract terms and conditions (federal requirements) that continue for the life of the project. FTA requires MoDOT to assure compliance with these requirements.

MoDOT will soon increase its efforts to review agencies for conformance to these requirements.

The Transit Section of the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) will hold six (6) workshops in early November to address federal transit grant requirements and MoDOT's new approach for compliance reviews. MoDOT has retained Milligan & Company to assist it with the implementation of this program. Milligan will make workshop presentations and work with MoDOT to conduct on-site grantee reviews. These workshops will provide technical assistance as well as assure greater compliance.
